Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

- Q: How is an anniversary weekend different than our original weekend?
A: The format of an original weekend is set according to the parameters set by Father Calvo. An anniversary weekend has more flexibility. It is typically a themed weekend, with presentations building on the theme. It usually is a deeper weekend because time does not have to be spent on the basics of reflection and dialogue. There are presentations and time for couple reflection and dialogue, but there is also time allotted after each presentation for voluntary open sharing.
- Q: We are not currently dialoguing; does that mean we should not attend?
A: Quite the contrary, this is a great opportunity to refresh the reflection and dialogue skills as well as to renew the closeness you felt at the end of your original weekend.
- Q: We are currently active with marriage encounter and we are continuing to dialogue – would we get anything out of this?
A: Absolutely, yes! The weekend will give you time to share in areas you may not have covered in the past. Further, it will allow you reflect and dialogue in these areas in more depth than you may have done on your own. Finally, you will be in an environment of other encountered couples who want to deepen their relationship and allow you to experience their sharing as well.
